Write 20 questions that can be answered yes or no, e.g. Is this your pen? Start each question with a different word. Do not use the word ought or words that end in -n't.

The 20 yes-no question words are called X-WORDS.

- 2. The x-words fall into four families. List five members of the $\underline{\text{BE}}$ family, three members of the $\underline{\text{DO}}$ family, three of the $\underline{\text{HAVE}}$ family and the nine remaining as the MODAL family.
- 3. Change all 20 questions into negative statements by moving the x-words and attaching $-\underline{n't}$ to them wherever possible. Do not change or add any other words except to negate.
- 4. Draw a box around the word or words that come between the two positions for the x-word in each sentence. This box contains the SUBJECT of the sentence.
