

## X-WORDS AND HIDDEN X-WORDS

## Task #3

*EACH PERSON IN YOUR GROUP SHOULD DO THIS TASK INDIVIDUALLY.*

1. Write a five-sentence paragraph telling a single incident that took place yesterday. Number the sentences in your paragraph. Only the *first* sentence should begin with the word Yesterday.
2. Mark every x-word in the paragraph by putting the letter 'x' right over it. Mark every hidden x-word (x).
3. Give your paper to someone else in your group. That person must change each of your sentences into its yes-no question form using the same words that you used. (He will probably have to "pull out" some hidden x-words.)
4. Take your paper back and draw a box around the SUBJECT of each of your five sentences. Remember that the subject is everything that comes *between* the two places where the x-words have turned up.
