- 1. Make up a one-paragraph story that suits this situation: Recently a wise person told you to do something. You didn't know why you should do that thing, so you asked the person about it. The person gave you a good reason, but you ignored it and did not do the thing you were told to do. Later on you regretted not having listened.
  - Tell the story in reported speech -- that is, do not use any quotation marks. Finish the story with a sentence that starts with the word <u>If</u>.
- Read your story to the group to see if you all agree that everything is in the past tense and follows the patterns of reported speech and if-tenses that we have studied.
